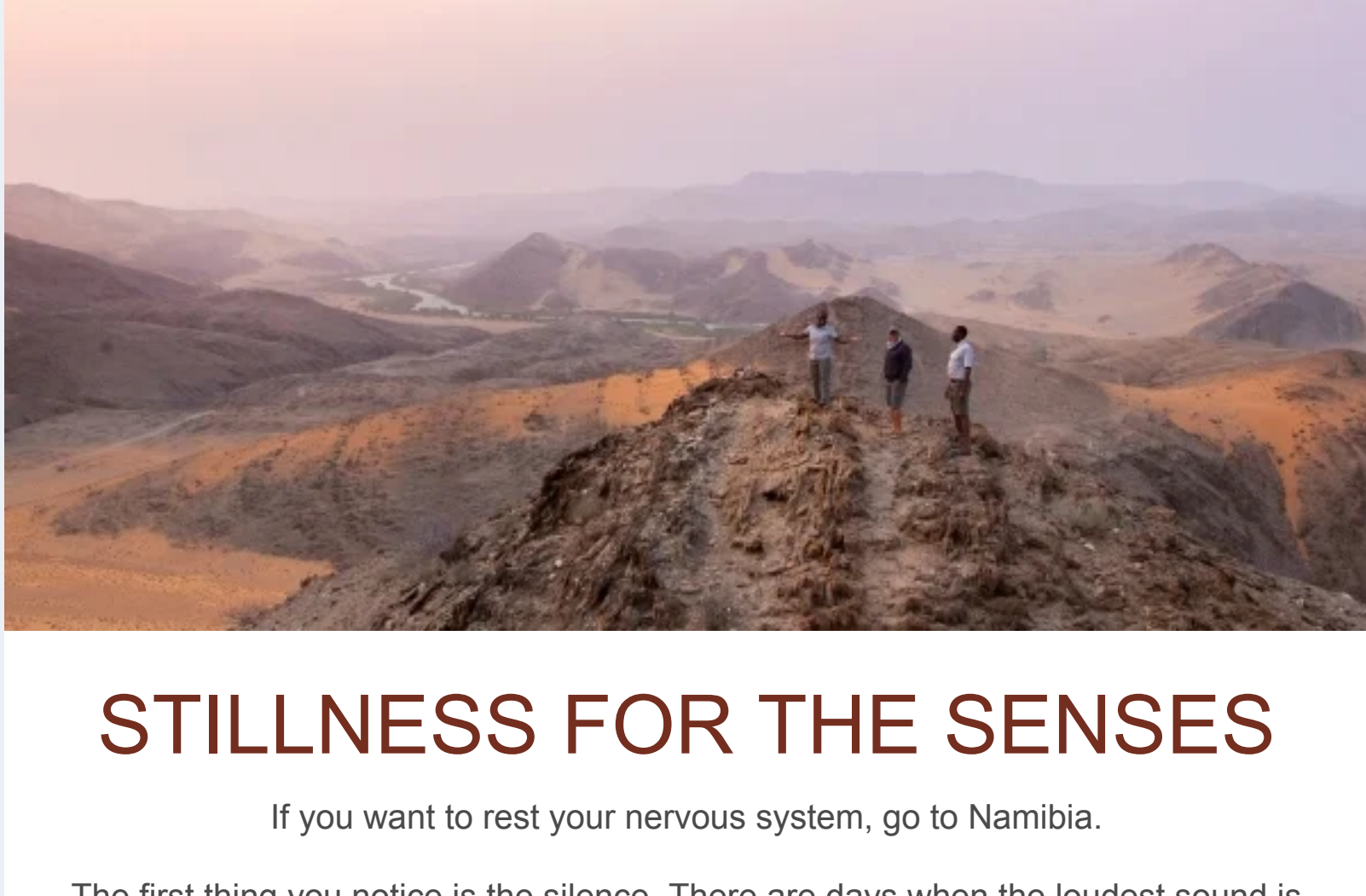
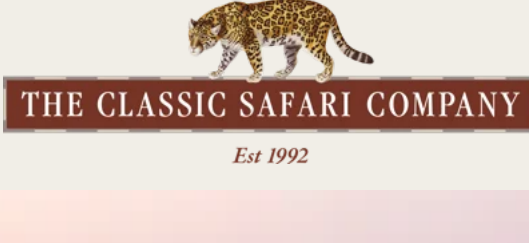




STILLNESS FOR THE SENSES

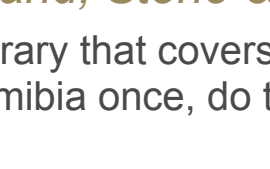
If you want to rest your nervous system, go to Namibia.

The first thing you notice is the silence. There are days when the loudest sound is the breeze rustling through tinder-dry grasses, or your own footsteps crunching across the ochre earth. Then comes the dark. In the desert, the night is absolute. No light pollution, no glow on the horizon, just the Southern stars scattered across the endless heavens.

Landscapes appear devoid of life: blackened trees stand sentinel over the clay pans of Deadvlei and rusting shipwrecks lie half-swallowed by the Skeleton Coast. But then, almost imperceptibly, life emerges. Desert-adapted elephants pick their way along dry riverbeds, dusty rhinos appear through the shimmering heat, and flamingos flock along the Atlantic coastline in clouds of brilliant pink. Meanwhile, remote Himba and Herero communities draw life from the land to feed rich cultural traditions that have endured for millennia.

In Namibia, you can silence technology's beeps and pings to rediscover how tiny your place is within the universe. Give your nervous system permission to switch off and enjoy the privilege of feeling wonderfully, refreshingly insignificant.

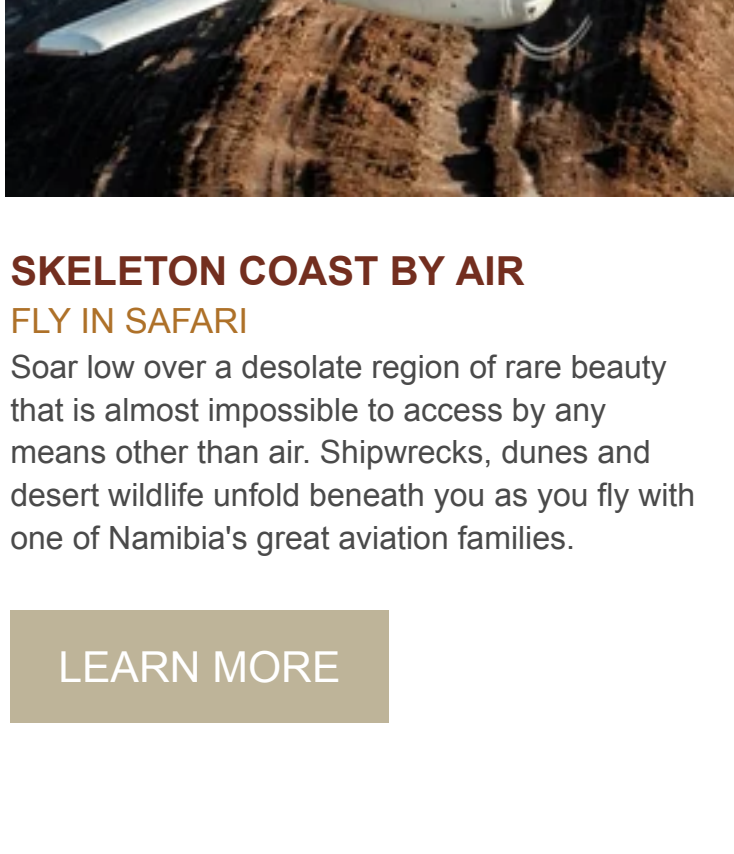

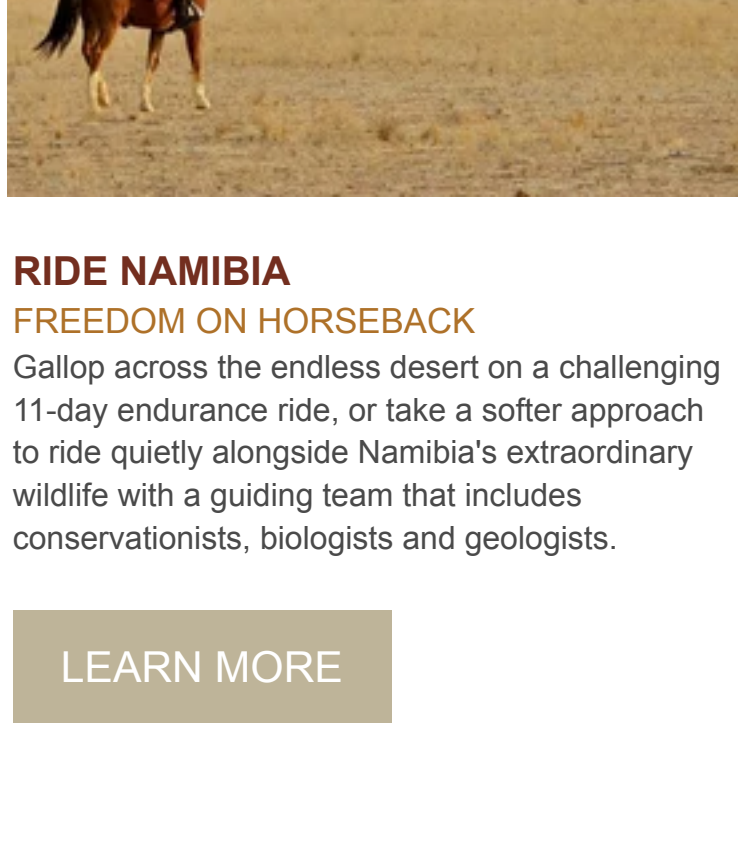


SKELETON COAST BY AIR

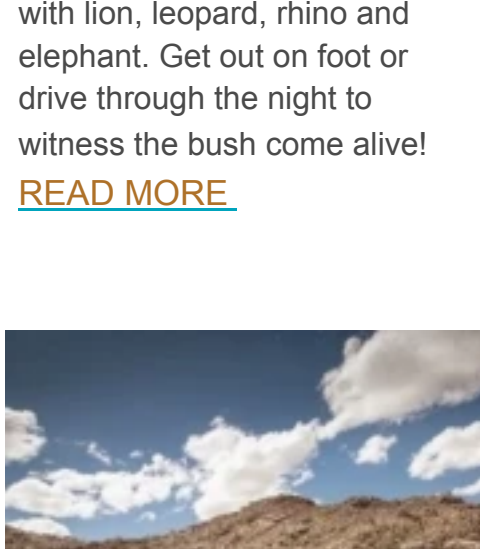

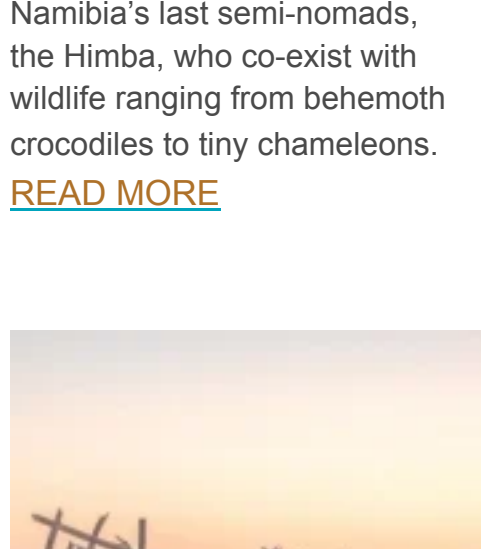

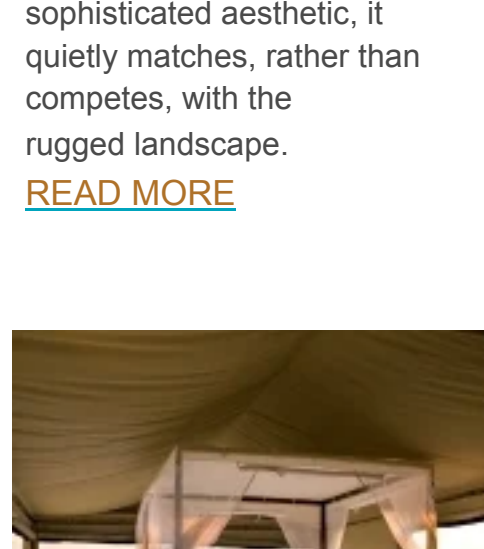
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SERRA CAFEMA

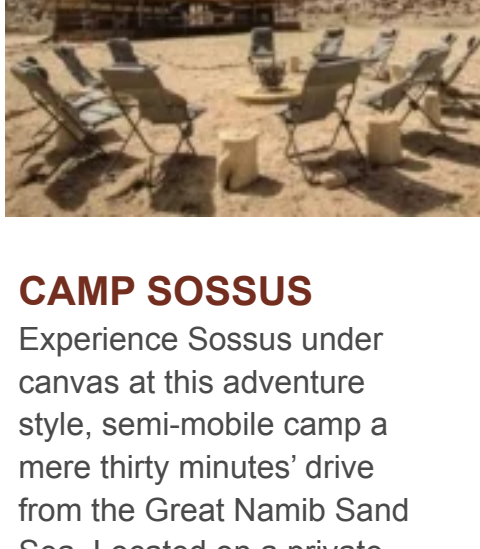
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HOANIB VALLEY CAMP

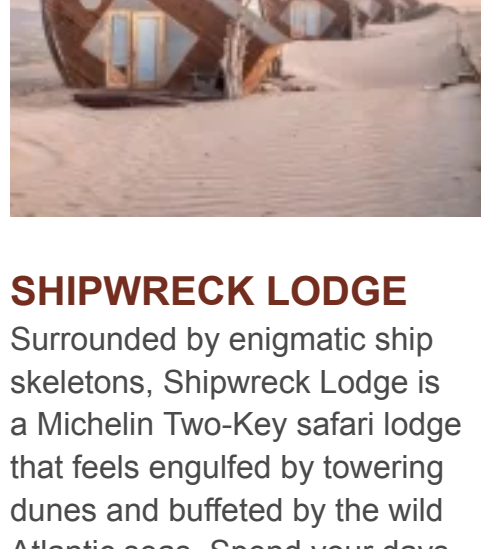

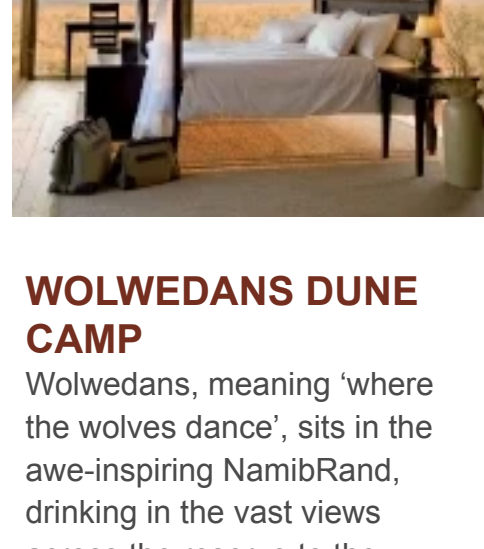

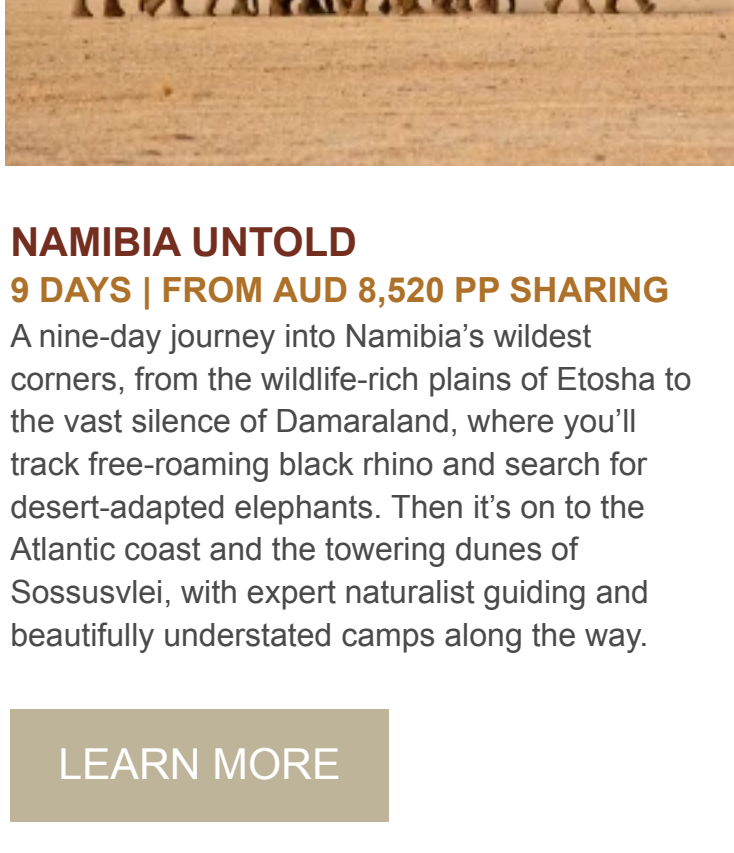
WOLWEDANS DUNE CAMP

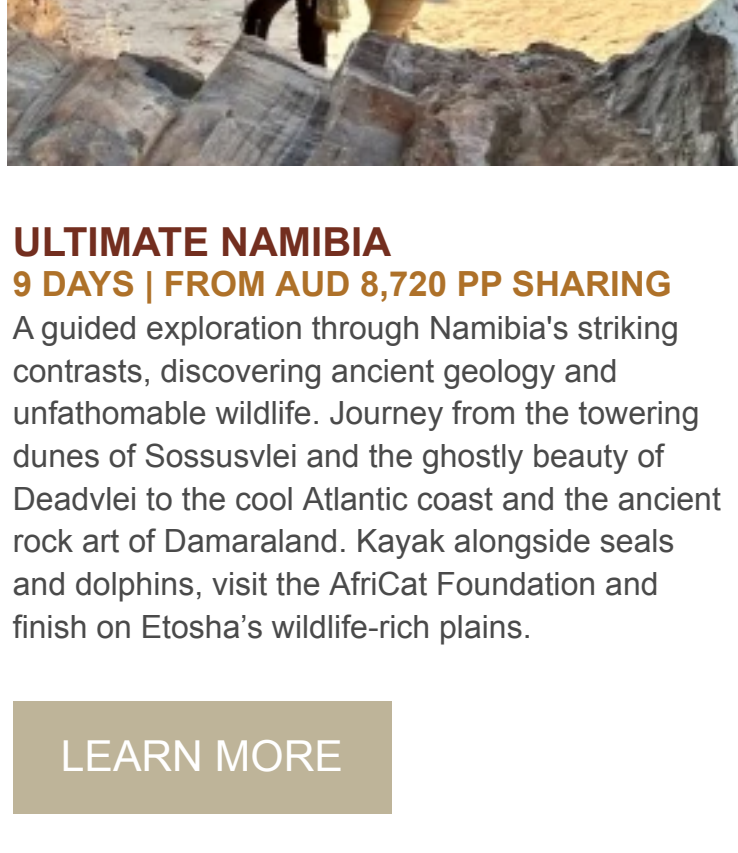

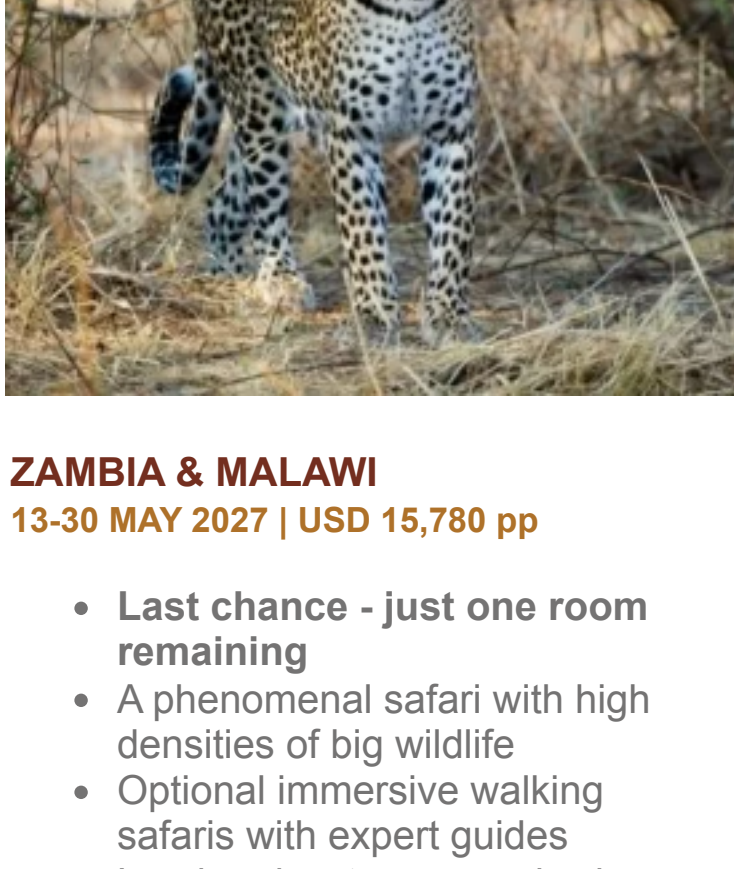

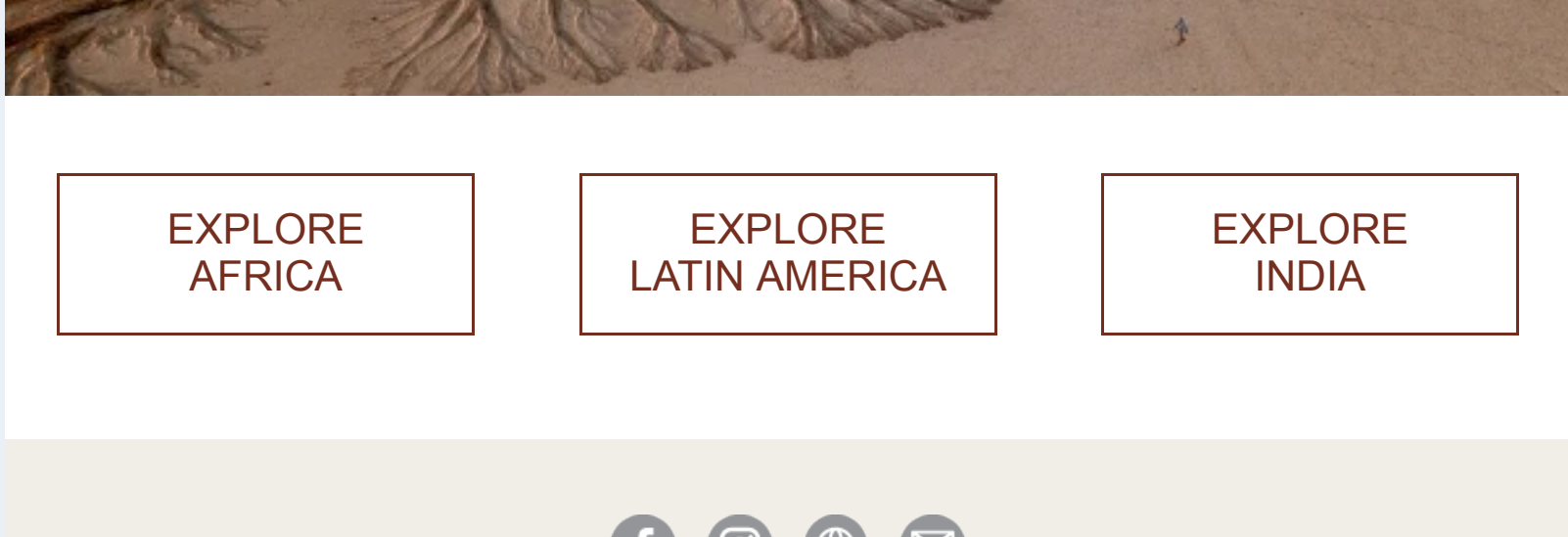
